LAKE WENTWORTH ASSOCIATION 2011 VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES

The table below lists a variety of ways that you can contribute to the health and protection of our lakes. The need is for a little help from many people rather than a lot of help from a few! Without YOUR help, the work to maintain the quality and beauty of our lakes may well go undone. Please note that two people can sign up as a team to share one volunteer activity.

Volunteer opportunity	What's involved	Comments
A. Assisting with water quality monitoring	Taking water samples from designated areas of Lake Wentworth and Crescent Lake. Sampling takes about an hour once per week during the summer months.	In addition to sampling on the lakes, one or more volunteers are also needed to drive water samples to the state testing laboratory in Concord.
B. Weed Watchers	Using canoes, kayaks, or small boats, volunteers patrol along shorelines near their properties twice per month, looking for invasive species of aquatic plants such as variable milfoil. The activity should take about an hour.	The LWA and state Department of Environmental services provide training and a weed identification kit.
C. Milfoil management	Volunteers can provide support to divers by monitoring the dive site and taking harvested weeds into boats, or they can join weed pulling excursions along the shore. Activity typically takes place Saturday mornings and lasts about two to three hours.	To give volunteers an opportunity to plan, volunteer leaders will provide advance notice of dates and times of weed management activities.
D. Lake Host	Help perform courtesy boat inspections for milfoil at Mast Landing.	Looking for volunteers to work mid-week.
E. Newsletter/Web site	Help put together a newsletter to inform the lake community about the lakes and the people who use and protect them. Provide informative material for the LWA Web site (www.lwa.org) or <i>The Zephyr</i> .	Write an article, suggest a topic, pass on news.
F. Shore Rep	Represent your shore. Attend the 2 summer meetings and distribute the LWA Directory and <i>The Zephyr</i> to your neighbors.	
G. NH Boat Museum/ LWA Merchandise	Assist visitors to the museum and help with sale of LWA merchandise	Volunteering helps raise funds for the LWA and thanks the boat museum for providing space for us.
